



NETWORK ACCEPTABLE USAGE & BYOD AGREEMENT

Student Agreement:

I have read the following agreement and hereby agree that while using the College's Network and Internet ...

I understand that I will

- Be allowed one device only (not a mobile phone) to be connected to the school network
- I understand that I will be responsible for my own device at all times. Elwood College will not be responsible for loss, theft or damages that occur at school or on the way to and from school
- My device must be brought fully charged every day. Charging devices at school will not be permitted due to OH&S regulations
- Use the college's network facilities, internet access, cloud based services and websites solely for educational purposes as determined by the classroom teacher
- Respect the rights and privacy of others
- Behave according to the college's bullying and anti-harassment policy
- Maintain up to date virus software
- Refrain from derogatory or inflammatory remarks about an individual or group's race, religion, national origin, physical attributes or sexually explicit and objectionable subject matter
- Observe all copyright laws, including those relating to computer software
- Report any security lapses that I may discover
- Report any obscene or offensive material I encounter
- Scan portable storage devices

I understand that I will not

- Be able to connect a mobile phone to the network
- Attempt to connect any other device to the network other than my nominated device
- Disclose my own or others' personal information over the Internet
- Bring Elwood College into disrepute in any way whatsoever
- Allow anyone else to use my account or give my password to anyone else
- Attempt to alter or change the system in any way
- Attempt to bypass network security in any way on the College network, this includes the use of VPN's, VPN software or websites designed to bypass existing security
- Physically damage or deface computers or ICT equipment
- Attempt to retrieve, view or disseminate any obscene, offensive, explicit or illegal material
- Threaten, abuse or harass any other user
- Use another student's account or tamper with another student's account in any way
- Download or print information without permission from a member of staff
- Use chat channels without permission from a member of staff

For breaches of the Network Acceptable Usage Agreement, students can face a number of consequences depending on the severity of the breach and the context of the situation. More than one consequence may apply for a given offence. Serious or repeated offences will result in stronger penalties, such as:

- Removal of BYOD privileges
- Removal of network access privileges
- Removal of email privileges
- Removal of internet access privileges
- Removal of printing privileges
- Paying to replace damaged equipment
- Other consequences as outlined in the school's discipline policy.
