Dear Students, Staff and Families,

The timeline for the [staged return to onsite learning](#) is being brought forward, with restrictions that were to be lifted on Tuesday 26 October now to be lifted from Friday 22 October.

In addition to the update below some important dates:

- Year 12 Graduation this Friday, October 22 at 3:30pm – live broadcast
- Curriculum Day on Monday, November 1
- Melbourne Cup Day on Tuesday, November 2
- Presentation Evening (time TBC) on Wednesday, November 24 – live broadcast

The updated Roadmap, which is based on advice from the Victorian Chief Health Officer, sets out the staged return to onsite learning in Term 4.
