



ELWOOD COLLEGE INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM ENROLMENT POLICY

For all students in addition to IED required documents, Elwood College requires the following in order to be accepted into the College:

- Passport details must be present
- Full set of reports must be present
- Reports must have results above 80%
- An interview will be conducted via Skype/FaceTime. If the student wishes to go into mainstream classes the interview will be conducted in English. If the student is going into the English Language Centre the interview will be conducted in their native language.

In addition:

For students going directly into **year 7 and 8:**

- Students must be in Stage 2.1/2.2 on the EAL Continuum, which is equivalent to CEFR A2+, IELTS 4, TOEFL 31+ or Cambridge English Scale Score 130+

For students going directly into **year 9 and 10:**

Students must be in EAL Stage 2.2/2.3 on the EAL Continuum, which is equivalent to CEFR B1, IELTS 4.5 - 5.5, TOEFL 34+, or Cambridge English Scale Score 140+

For students going directly into **year 11:**

- Students must be in Stage 3.1 or higher on the EAL Continuum which is equivalent to CEFR B2, IELTS 5.5 - 6.5, TOEFL 60+, or Cambridge English Scale Score 160+

For students going directly into **year 12:**

- Students must be in Stage 4.1 or higher on the EAL Continuum which is equivalent to CEFR C1, IELTS 6.5 or higher, TOEFL 93+ or Cambridge English Scale Score 180+
