Construction at Elwood College

Dear Neighbour,

As you may be aware, Elwood College are in the process of upgrading their school to ensure that students have access to the best facilities in which to learn.

As part of these works, a new multi-purpose sports field will be constructed as part of a Community Joint Use Agreement (CJUA) with the Melbourne Cricket Club (MCC) Foundation. The multi-purpose sports field will be built as part of the school's Masterplan and will be located on vacant land adjacent to Goldsmith and Shelley Street. The new sporting facility will be used exclusively by the school during school hours and then by the MCC, other community organisations and groups via a schedule that is yet to be confirmed.

Preliminary works to begin construction, including site surveys, soil remediation, site clearing and excavation, is expected to begin shortly. Construction related works are planned to start by the week ending 8 November 2019.

Throughout the project, we will strive to maintain the privacy of all residents and to minimise potential disruptions such as noise, dust and traffic.

To ensure minimal interruption to residents and the school community, all construction will take place between 7am – 5pm Monday – Friday and 9am – 3pm Saturdays as set by City of Port Phillip. If you have any questions in the short term relating to the construction, please contact the school on (03) 9531 9566 and we will refer them to our Superintendent of Works. When construction commences we will also provide updated contact details for the Site Manager.
